## **INTER-SCHOOL QUIZ COMPETITION**

### **29 November 2022**

The Centre for Constitutional Studies organized the Inter-school Quiz competition on constitutional law on 29-11-2022 at Mar Gregorios College of Law. The competition was held to promote a deeper understanding and appreciation of the principles and provisions of the Constitution among high school students and higher secondary school students. The competition drew 31 high school teams from various schools. Each group consisted of two students and was led by a mentor. The competition was divided into two rounds: preliminary and final. The preliminary round consisted of 50 questions, and six teams advanced to the final round. The final round consists of four constitutional law-related questions. The questions covered topics such as Indian constitutional history and basic fundamental principles. Clinton Damien, the Mar Gregorios College of Law Librarian, was the competition's quiz master. The competition lasted for 3 hours and was judged by the student coordinators of the centre for constitutional studies. The team from Sarvodaya Central Vidyalaya, Nalanchira, emerged as the overall winner after a close and intense competition. The team members thoroughly understood the subject and consistently provided well-informed and articulate responses. They received a cash prize of

Rs. 2,000 and a trophy. The second-place prize was awarded to the team from Navajeevan Bethany Vidyalaya, who received a cash prize of thousand five hundred rupees, and the third place prize was awarded to the Government Girls HSS Pattom, who received a cash prize of thousand rupees. They were also given trophies. The participants were impressed by the performances of all of the participating teams, who demonstrated a high level of knowledge and enthusiasm for constitutional law. The inter-school quiz competition on constitutional law was a valuable opportunity for students to learn more about this important subject and to test their knowledge in a competitive setting. It also provided a platform for students to interact with peers and exchange ideas and perspectives on constitutional law.


