

Language is a vital tool for communication, and proficiency in English is increasingly important in today's academic and professional landscape. Recognizing this need, the Centre for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship organized a 30-hour Certificate Course in Elementary English for first-year students. The program aimed to provide foundational language skills to help students excel in their studies and future endeavors. The primary objective of the course was to enhance the participants' abilities in reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Many first-year students come from diverse linguistic backgrounds and face challenges in adapting to the academic environment, which often relies heavily on English. The course was carefully designed to address these challenges by focusing on basic grammar, vocabulary building, and interactive learning activities.

The course was structured into four modules: basic grammar and sentence structure, listening and speaking skills, reading skills, and writing skills. In the grammar module, students learned about parts of speech, tenses, and constructing coherent sentences. The listening and speaking module incorporated activities like dialogues, role-plays, and pronunciation practice, helping students gain confidence in conversational English. The reading module emphasized comprehension, while the writing module taught students to draft essays, letters, and emails.

Thirty one first year students from BA LLB, BCOM LLB AND BBA LLB attended the classes. The course begins on 5th December 2023 which spans for 6 months and finished the classes on 10th July 2024. The written exam was conducted on 2nd August 2024. The classes were taken by Dr. Arya. C.A, (Assistant professor, Department of English)

Interactive teaching methodologies made the course engaging and effective. Instructors used audio-visual aids to create an immersive learning environment. Role-plays and group discussions encouraged participation, while weekly assessments and personalized feedback helped track progress and address individual challenges.

The outcome of the course was overwhelmingly positive. Students reported significant improvement in their language skills, particularly in speaking and comprehension. Many participants expressed gratitude for the opportunity, noting that the course helped them feel more confident and prepared for academic tasks. A feedback survey revealed that the majority of students found the program beneficial.

The Certificate Course in Elementary English proved to be a valuable initiative for first-year students. It not only improved their language skills but also boosted their confidence and readiness to face academic and professional challenges.
